An Act relative to postage paid absentee ballots.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 87 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "envelopes.", In the lines 15
- 3 through 16, the following words:
- 4 Postage required for mailing the envelope to the appropriate city or town clerk shall be
- 5 paid in advance by the secretary of the commonwealth.
