The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to sex offenders.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section 178K of chapter 6 of the General
- 2 Laws, as so amended by chapter 38 of the Acts of 2013, is hereby amended by inserting, in the
- 3 second sentence, after the word "Investigation." the following sentences:-
- 4 No sex offender designated as a level 2 or 3 offenders shall establish a home address or
- 5 intended home address or any other living accommodation within 500 feet of the property on
- 6 which any public or private school, licensed day care center, or any other child care facility is
- 7 located. Nor shall the offender accept employment within 500 feet of the property on which any
- 8 public or private school, licensed day care center, or any other child care facility is located.
