An Act authorizing mushroom picking for personal use on certain state park lands.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 132A of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 2D the
- 2 following section:-
- 3 Section 2E. The commissioner shall authorize any person to take mushrooms from any
- 4 state parks, state forest recreation areas and state reservations under the control of the
- 5 commissioner provided such taking is for personal use only. The commonwealth shall have no
- 6 liability to any person or the heirs or assigns of any such person who engages in the taking of
- 7 mushrooms from any state parks, state forest recreation areas and state reservations under the
- 8 control of the commissioner.
