In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to motor vehicle premiums.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The twelve paragraph of section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the sixth and seventh sentences
- 3 and inserting in place thereof the following 2 sentences:-
- 4 The registrar shall develop a system for separately reporting all non-moving violations.
- 5 When the registrar has implemented the system, all non-moving violations shall not be
- 6 considered surchargeable incidents.
