An Act relative to an underground storage tank petroleum product cleanup fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 29 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting, after section 2KKKK, the following section:-

3           "Section 2LLLL. There shall be established and set up on the books of the  
4 commonwealth a separate fund to be known as the Underground Storage Tank Petroleum  
5 Product Cleanup Fund. Amounts credited to said fund shall be used, subject to appropriation, for  
6 the purposes set forth in chapter 21J. There shall be credited to such fund: any fees, penalties,  
7 and other amounts collected pursuant to said chapter 21J; any appropriation, grant, gift or other  
8 contribution explicitly made to such fund; and any interest earned on monies within the fund.  
9 Expenditures made from said fund during any fiscal year shall not exceed the cash balance of

- 10 said fund as of December 31 of the calendar year preceding the beginning of such fiscal year less
- 11 the total of the amounts specified in subsections (b), (c) and (d) of section 4 of said chapter 21J."
