The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Fourth General Court
(2025-2026)

An Act relative to election laws.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 47C of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the first paragraph the following:-

3 The state secretary shall honor requests for standard voter registration and voter history
4 information in a timely fashion, with said information provided no later than one week after such
5 request is made. During early voting periods, the state secretary shall maintain an updated list of
6 registered voters who have cast early ballots, whether in person or by mail, and shall transmit
7 this information to state party committees, via electronic mail, on a daily basis.

8 SECTION 2. Section 25B of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2022
9 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (k) the following subsection:-

10 (l) Not less than four times per year, the state secretary shall provide state party
11 committees with a list of registered voters who have requested a vote by mail ballot.
