Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 11F¹/₂ of Chapter 25A of the General Law, 2016 Official Edition, is hereby

5 conventional municipal solid waste plant technology in commercial use";

6 3) In line 23-25 by striking out the phrase "provided, however, that facilities using

7 biomass fuel shall be low emission, use efficient energy conversion technologies and fuel that is

- 8 produced by means of sustainable forestry practices;";
- 9 4) In line 33 by inserting after the words, "wood and", in line 13, the following

10 phrase "; (F) biomass; (G) municipal solid waste;";

11	5)	In line 33 by replacing the phrase "(F)" with (H)".	
12	6)	In lines 36-37 by striking out the phrase "eligible biomass";	
13	7)	In line 41 by striking out the phrase "eligible biomass";	
14	8)	In line 47 by striking out the phrase "eligible biomass";	
15	9)	In line 50 by inserting after the word, "feasible;", the following word "and";	
16	10)	In line 50 by striking out the phrase "eligible biomass";	
17	11)	In lines 52-58 by striking out the phrase "; and (v) in consultation with the	
18 department of conservation and recreation, for forest-derived biomass, requirements that fuel			
19	19 shall be provided by means of conservation and recreation, for forest-derived biomass,		
20	requirements that fuel shall be provided by means of sustainable forestry practices; provided,		
21	1 however, that the department shall adopt any existing or new biomass fuel sustainability		
22	standards if deemed appropriate by the department after a public comment process.".
