**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court
(2021-2022)**

An Act increasing the annual stipend for members of the Commonwealth’s hazardous material response teams.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5 of chapter 21K of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by striking out, in line 140, the figure "\$3,000" and inserting in place thereof
- 3 the following figure:- \$5,000.
