Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 2 (b) of chapter 32A, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding after the words "of Suffolk county," in line 16, the following:-

- 4 social services under contracts with departments within the executive office of health and human
- 5 services and the executive office of elder affairs,"
