An Act relative to flood storage.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the  
2 Metropolitan Area Planning Council shall conduct a study of potential flood storage locations  
3 and water quality improvements in the Alewife Brook watershed in the Cities of Cambridge and  
4 Somerville, and in the Towns of Arlington and Belmont.

5           Within one hundred and eighty (180) days of passage of this act, the Metropolitan Area  
6 Planning Council shall submit a report to the clerks of the House and Senate detailing a plan  
7 concerning the implementation of said study.

8           SECTION 2: A sum of \$100,000 shall be appropriate for the purpose of funding the  
9 study required by SECTION 1."
