Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

3 (h) The council shall appoint a full time food system coordinator as an employee. The 4 food system coordinator shall have access to all relevant agency meetings; serve in an advisory 5 capacity to all relevant departments to inventory existing state programs which relate to the food 6 system across all state agencies, including, but not limited to, agencies associated with the 7 council; facilitate communication and resource collaboration across state agencies; develop and 8 track metrics related to food system goals; identify opportunities to eliminate duplicative efforts 9 and strengthen complementary programs and projects; identify gaps in services and supports and 10 make recommendations; and provide input to help coordinate outreach to underserved 11 communities. The food system coordinator shall submit a report 1 week prior to each council 12 meeting with findings, progress updates, and recommendations to the clerks of the senate and the

- 14 commissioners.
