An Act designating a State Road in the city of Waltham as Landry Way.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by
- 2 the authority of the same as follows: The access road located behind the Francis Cabot Lowell
- 3 Mill at 190 Moody street in the city of Waltham, and parallel to Landry Park, that is owned and
- 4 maintained by the department of conservation and recreation, shall be designated and known as
- 5 Landry Way for identification purposes and to facilitate the making of improvements and repairs.
- 6 The department of conservation and recreation shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing
- 7 such designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
