## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to victim access to sex offender information.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Section 178I of chapter 6, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended

2 by inserting after the word "offender", in line 15, the following words: --; provided, however,

3 that prior to the final classification by the board the victim of said sex offender, or the

4 parent/guardian of the victim, may obtain the following information regarding the sex offender:

5 (1) the home address and any secondary address, (2) the work address, (3) a photograph of the

6 sex offender, if available, and (4) the name and address of the institution of higher learning

7 where the sex offender works or is enrolled as a student.
