An Act relative to insurance surcharges.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as most recently  
2 amended by section 221 of chapter 68 of the acts of 2011, is hereby amended by inserting, in the  
3 thirteenth paragraph, at the end thereof, the following sentence:-

4 Driving a motor vehicle which has an expired inspection sticker shall not be considered a  
5 surchargeable incident.
