AN ACT RELATIVE TO LIQUOR LEGAL LIABILITY INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 12 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 20 of chapter 113
- 2 of the acts of 2008, is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- 3 No license shall be granted or renewed under the provisions of this section until the applicant or licensee provides
- 4 proof of coverage under a liquor legal liability insurance policy for bodily injury or death at a minimum limits of
- 5 two hundred fifty thousand dollars on account of injury to or death of one person, and five hundred thousand dollars
- 6 on account of any one accident resulting in injury to or death of more than one person.
