Kelcourse and Lenny Mirra relative to establishing a special commission (including members of the General Court) to study and determine the maintenance and upkeep needs of lakes, ponds, streams and other public waterways. Environment, Natural Resources and Agriculture.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to clean lakes and waterways in the commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, there is

2 hereby established a special commission to study and determine the maintenance and upkeep

3 needs of lakes, ponds, streams and other public waterways in the commonwealth. The

4 commission shall review said public waterways through a standardized evaluation criteria

5 established by the commission.

6 The commission shall consist of: the commissioner of the department of environmental 7 protection, or their designee; the commissioner of the department of conservation and recreation 8 or their designee; one member to be appointed by the Massachusetts water resources authority; 9 one member to be appointed by the speaker of the house; one member to be appointed by the 10 minority leader of the house; one member to be appointed by the senate president; one member 11 to be appointed by the senate minority leader; and two members to be appointed by the governor.

- 12 The commission shall file a report of their recommended regulations and its findings,
- 13 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry those recommendations into effect, by filing
- 14 the same with the clerks of the senate and the house of representatives no later than one year
- 15 after the passage of this act.
