#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to compensating a family member as caretaker.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, a family member may
- 2 be the designated paid caretaker for a member of the family with a traumatic brain injury
- 3 received while in military service. The prerequisites for this designation by the department of
- 4 public health and any other department shall include, but not be limited to, training and
- 5 certification.
