Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

174 of major life activity: (1) self-care; (2) receptive and expressive language; (3) learning; (4) 175 mobility; (5) self-direction; (6) capacity for independent living; and (7) economic self-176 sufficiency; and (v) reflects the individual's need for a combination and sequence of special. 177 interdisciplinary or generic services, supports or other assistance that is of a lifelong or extended 178 duration and is individually planned and coordinated; or (b) an individual under the age of 5 who 179 has a substantial developmental delay or specific congenital or acquired condition with a high 180 probability that the condition will result in a developmental disability if services are not 181 provided. A person who has a developmental disability may be considered to be mentally ill; 182 provided, however, that no person with a developmental disability shall be considered to be 183 mentally ill solely by reason of the person's developmental disability. 184 SECTION 54.
