## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 2 of Chapter 18B of the General Laws of Massachusetts is hereby amended
- 2 adding the following to line 14 therein:— Temporary residential programs, and/or certified
- 3 domestic violence programs shall be precluded from arbitrarily, or as a matter of procedure,
- 4 transferring local residents who are victims of domestic violence out of the area. This bill does
- 5 not inhibit the transfer of a local resident; however, if a victim of domestic violence has
- 6 legitimate reason to believe that she will be safe in a local facility, then she shall not be
- 7 prevented from staying if vacancies are available. No policy or program shall turn away a local
- 8 victim of domestic violence in the name of safety
