An Act to provide further transparency in public construction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Chapter 149, Section 26 of the Massachusetts General Laws is hereby amended by

2 inserting at the end of the first paragraph the following: Said collective bargaining agreements or

- 3 understandings between organized labor and employers shall be made publicly available by the
- 4 commissioner through the website of the Division of Occupational Safety.
