### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act encouraging municipal recycling and composting.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 8H of Chapter 40 of the general laws is herby amended by striking
- 2 in line 1 the word "may" and inserting in place thereof the word "shall"
- 3 And striking in line 1 the words "by approval of the local legislative body"
- 4 And striking in line 7 the word "may" and inserting in place thereof the word "shall"
- 5 And striking in line 9 the words "designated by the local legislative body"
