In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act allowing the city of Everett to increase the fee for lodging house licenses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 23 of chapter 140 of the General

2 Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the city of Everett is hereby authorized

3 to charge a fee of no greater than \$300 for a lodging house license.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
