AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BARGAINABILITY OF HEALTH INSURANCE FOR PART-TIME MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 32B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence of subsection (d) in line
- 3 36 the following: Persons who are ineligible because their duties require less than twenty
- 4 hours, regularly, during the regular work week may be provided health insurance pursuant to the
- 5 provisions of a collective bargaining agreement.
