By Mr. Joyce, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 109) of Brian A. Joyce, Linda Dorcena Forry and Walter F. Timilty for legislation to authorize the town of Milton to grant a license for the sale of wines and malt beverages to be drunk on the premises of a certain restaurant. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act authorizing the Town of Milton to grant a license for the sale of wines and malt beverages to be drunk on the premises of a certain restaurant.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 11 and 17 of chapter 138 of the
2 General laws, the licensing authority of the Town of Milton may grant to B&D Ichiro, Inc.,
3 d/b/a/ Ichiro Sushi, a license for the sale of wines and malt beverages to be drunk on the
4 premises of the restaurant located at 538A Adams Street, Milton, MA. The license shall be
5 subject to all of said chapter 138, except said sections 11 and 17. The licensing authority shall
6 not approve the transfer of the license to any other location.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
