AN ACT RELATIVE TO CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS FOR OIL BURNER
TECHNICIANS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 67A of chapter 146 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2004
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the first paragraph the following
- 3 paragraph:-
- 4 The department shall promulgate regulations which shall require the renewal of such
- 5 certifications every two years. Commencing with the renewal of certification on July 1, 2007, all
- 6 individuals certified by the commonwealth as an oil burner technician shall demonstrate the
- 7 satisfactory completion of continuing education courses as determined by the department.
