An Act relative to fair fines to increase local revenue .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Section 9 of chapter 140 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting, in line 6, 2 after the words "suspend or revoke his license" the following words:- "or impose a fine for the 3 first offense within a six month period of not less than $\$ 500$ and not more than $\$ 1,000$, for the second offense within a six month period of not less than $\$ 1,000$ and not more than $\$ 2,000$, for 5 the third offense within a six month period of not less than $\$ 2,000$ and not more than $\$ 5,000$, for 6 the fourth offense within a six month period of not less than $\$ 5,000$ and not more than $\$ 10,000$,
