Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1: Section 29 of Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after Line 8 the following new paragraph:-
- No person may sell a ticket or share if the only consideration given is a promise, in fact
- 4 or in law, to make payment at a future time.
