#### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to workers compensation insurance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5 of Chapter 152 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following:- "; provided further, that
- 3 notwithstanding any general or special law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, any employer
- 4 conducting business in the Commonwealth for fewer than twenty (20) days per calendar year
- 5 which can produce proof of workers compensation insurance considered valid in any state of the
- 6 United States of America, shall be deemed to be in compliance with all requirements relative to
- 7 the provision of workers compensation insurance in the Commonwealth."
