Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 51 of Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 adding the following paragraph:

3 Any health care facility licensed pursuant to this section shall provide transportation via taxi, car
4 or bus service or other form of private or public transportation for the return commute from the
5 institution for all resident physicians, medical students and other health care providers who have
6 worked for more than 16 consecutive hours, and for any health care provider who judges herself
7 or himself to be too fatigued to safely operate a motor vehicle.
