In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act prohibiting the obstruction of state highways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section 106. Whoever commits or attempts to commit any act to obstruct, block, detain,
- 3 or render passage impossible, unsafe or unreasonably difficult for the normal movement of
- 4 traffic, commerce, or any emergency medical services on a limited access or express state
- 5 highway in any manner that is dangerous to the general public, shall be punished by
- 6 imprisonment in a state prison for not more than 10 years.
