An Act amending the enclosure for public and semipublic outdoor inground swimming pools..
Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

8 is hereby further amended, by inserting after the third sentence, the following sentence:- An

9 aluminum picket fence, including its gate, used as an enclosure for a public or semipublic 10 outdoor inground swimming pool shall not have footholds, the spacing between vertical pickets,

11 shall not exceed 4 inches including the spacing under the fence or any other opening, and the 12 height of the fence shall not be less than 6 feet.
