## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to food labeling.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department of public
- 2 health shall implement a food labeling program for commercially caught, landed and sold
- 3 saltwater fish including but not limited to: tuna, mackerel, swordfish, grouper, striped bass and
- 4 bluefish. The label shall provide the consumer with information concerning the safety and risk
- 5 factors of consumption of the fish based on toxin levels in the fish and their hazards to human
- 6 health, in particular the health of young children, women of child-bearing age and pregnant
- 7 women.
