**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to medical malpractice.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2 of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after paragraph 7 the following paragraph:-
- 3 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, if a registered physician is convicted
- 4 of 3 cases of medical malpractice the board shall revoke said physician's registration.
