### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to delivered food.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 SECTION 1: Chapter 270 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Office Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after section 26 the following section:-
- 3 Section 27. No food delivery provider operating within the Commonwealth shall use
- 4 staples in order to seal bags or containers carrying raw or prepared foods.
- 5 This act shall take effect upon passage.
