By Mr. Humason, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1269) of Donald F. Humason, Jr., Bruce E. Tarr, Viriato M. deMacedo and Todd M. Smola for legislation relative to non-resident firearm license fees. Public Safety and Homeland Security.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to non-resident firearm license fees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 131F of Chapter 140 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as
2	appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, shall be amended by deleting the following sentence;
3	"Such license shall be valid for a period of one year but the colonel may renew such
4	license, if in his discretion, such renewal is necessary."
5	And replacing it with the following: Such license shall be valid for a period of six years.
6	SECTION 2. Section 131F of Chapter 140 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as
7	appearing in the 2010 Official Edition, shall be amended by deleting the second paragraph in its
8	entirety and replacing it with the following:-
9	A license issued under this section shall be marked "License to Carry Firearms". The fee
10	for an application for the license shall be \$40, which shall be payable to the licensing authority
11	and shall not be prorated or refunded in case of revocation or denial. The licensing authority

12 shall retain \$20 of the fee; \$20 of the fee shall be deposited into the general fund of the commonwealth. A license issued under the provisions of this section to a non-resident who is in 13 the employ of a bank, public utility corporation, or a firm engaged in the business of transferring 14 monies, or business of similar nature, or a firm licensed as a private detective under the 15 provisions of chapter one hundred and forty-seven, and whose application is endorsed by his 16 employer, or who is a member of the armed services and is stationed within the territorial 17 18 boundaries of the commonwealth and has the written consent of his commanding officer, may be issued for any term not to exceed six years, and said licenses shall expire in accordance with the 19 20 provisions of section one hundred and thirty-one.
