An Act extending creditable service for Teacher Corps service and Teach for America participants.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 4 in Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006  
2 Official Edition, is amended by inserting in subsection (r) after the words “Peace Corps” the  
3 following:- , former National Teacher Corps program, or the Teach for America program.
