The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to the retirement of school social workers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 110 of the Acts of 1990 is hereby amended by adding following 2 section:-
- 3 Section 5. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the provisions of
- 4 section 1 of this act shall be retroactive to the date the school social worker was first employed as
- 5 a school social worker and otherwise met the eligibility requirements of the state teachers'
- 6 retirement system or the State-Boston retirement system.
- 7 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2 of Chapter 114 of the Acts
- 8 of 2000, school social workers shall have an additional 90 days from the passage of this act to
- 9 elect into the alternative superannuation retirement benefit program established for members of
- 0 the teachers' retirement system and teachers who are members of the State-Boston retirement
- 11 system.
