In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to public warehousemen.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 105 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 5-7, the words "upon the payment of
- 3 a license fee as determined annually by the commissioner of administration under the provision
- 4 of section three B of chapter seven" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- A public
- 5 warehouseman shall obtain an annual license from the commissioner upon the payment of a
- 6 license fee as determined by the commissioner of administration under the provision of section
- 7 3B of chapter 7.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of chapter 105 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2012
- 9 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 3, following the word "corporations" the
- 10 following words:-provided that the corporation's chief executive officer shall be responsible for

- licensure for the purposes of this act and shall be concurrently listed with the corporation as thelicensee.
- SECTION 3. Section 1 of chapter 105 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by inserting, after the first paragraph, the following paragraph:-
- The department shall make and promulgate regulations which shall require the b-annual renewal of such licenses, provided further that, from time to time, the department may alter, amend and repeal, rules and regulations relative to the licensure and operation of public

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warehouses.
