An Act relative to the residency requirements of assistant treasurers and collectors..  
*Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to  
[Emergency Preamble Text] convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sixth and seventh sentences of section 39A of chapter 41 of the General  
2 Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the words  
3 “and a resident of the commonwealth”.

4           SECTION 2. The sixth and seventh sentences of section 39C of said chapter 41 of the  
5 General Laws is hereby further amended by striking out the words “and a resident of the  
6 commonwealth”.

7           SECTION 3. This act will take effect upon its passage.
