An Act relative to accountability of law enforcement professionals.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (9) of Section 4 of Chapter 151B of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, shall be amended by inserting the following language  
3 after “employer,”: “except any law enforcement agency,”

4 SECTION 2. Subsection (9 1/2) of Section 4 of Chapter 151B of the General Laws shall  
5 be amended by inserting the following language after “employer”: “, except any law enforcement  
6 agency,”
