By Mr. Moore, petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1341) of Moore for legislation to establish a sick leave bank for Christopher Lanoue [Public Service].

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Christopher Lanoue, an employee of the Department of Correction.

*Whereas*, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is forthwith to make to immediately establish a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Department of Correction, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any special or general law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
2 Department of Correction shall establish a sick leave bank for Christopher Lanoue, an employee  
3 of the department. Any employee of the department may voluntarily contribute one or more  
4 sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Christopher Lanoue. Whenever  
5 Christopher Lanoue terminates employment with the department or requests to dissolve the sick  
6 leave bank, the balance of the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the Department of

- 7 Correction extended sick leave bank. Sick leave bank days may not be used for absences
- 8 unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as
- 9 determined by the department.
