Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 7 of chapter 58A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 official edition, is amended by adding after the words "under the provisions of section 3B of
- 3 chapter 7." in line 32, the following words:
- 4 -Notwithstanding the above, persons over the age of 65 who file an appeal from the board
- 5 of assessors and with a gross income of 200% of the federal poverty level shall pay an entry fee
- 6 of twenty-five dollars.
