## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to MassPort officers .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008  
2 Official Edition, is hereby further amended by inserting in the description of Group 4 in  
3 paragraph (g) of subdivision (2), in line 268, after the words “fire control men;” the following:—  
4 employees of the Massachusetts port authority who are employed as port officers and supervisors  
5 of said employees who shall include port sergeants, lieutenants, captains, assistant chiefs, deputy  
6 chiefs, and director;”
