An Act relative to Cecilia Davlin.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary and in  
2 order to promote the public good, the state retirement board shall pay to Cecilia Davlin the  
3 surviving former wife of James Davlin who shall be considered to have chosen option (D)  
4 designating her as his beneficiary, the benefit payable under section 5 of chapter 32 of the  
5 General Laws in monthly installments.
