An Act adjusting the pension wages of Robert B. Noonan..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, for purposes of  
2 calculating the retirement of Robert B. Noonan, the Massachusetts Teachers Retirement Board,  
3 in considering his regular compensation, shall include the wages earned for service as a  
4 supervisor of an after school activity in the Chelmsford school district from September 2000 to  
5 June 2002.
