### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to firefighters cessation program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 101A of Chapter 41 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding, in line 7,
- 2 after the word "section" the following:-"prior to the termination of a Firefighter or Police Officer
- 3 for violating this section, said employee shall be offered an opportunity to enter a smoking
- 4 cessation program. Subsequent violation may be cause for dismissal.
