An Act relative to the contribution for insurance premiums of certain retired employees.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 9E of chapter 32B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words “that unit.”, in line 27, the  
3 following words:- ; provided however, that the percentage of premium paid by a retired  
4 employee, at any time, will not be higher than the percent of premium paid upon retirement.
