In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to firefighter bargaining units.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 3 of Chapter 150E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the first paragraph the following
- 3 sentences:-
- 4 The commission shall not find inappropriate and shall not modify or amend any
- 5 bargaining unit in any fire department in whole or in part engaging in, or having the
- 6 responsibility of fire fighting, if such a unit consists in whole or in part of uniform members of
- 7 the department subordinate to a fire commission, fire commissioner, public safety director, board
- 8 of engineers or chief of department. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
- 9 the labor relations commission shall not entertain any petition seeking to modify the scope of any
- 10 fire department bargaining unit.
