1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010

2 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in clause (1), by inserting after the word "insulin;" in line

3 171, the following words:- sales of blood test strips and lancets; sales of vitamin and mineral

4 supplements when prescribed by a licensed physician;
