An Act to support commercial fishing.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of Chapter 64H of the General Laws is hereby amended in subsection (o) by
2 inserting after the word “sales” in the third sentence thereof the words “and repairs” and further
3 by adding after the word “equipment” at the end thereof, the words “including but not limited to
4 nets, dredges, lines, hooks, traps, wires, and any components thereof, and any fish or natural or
5 artificial material to be utilized as bait
